Day 1 Sunday, September 25:

Evening flight to Paris with Air France. Dinner and breakfast will be served on board.

Day 2 Monday, September 26:

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Morning arrival in Paris where there will be a brief delay before boarding your connecting flight to Florence. Transfer by taxi to our very comfortable, three-star Hotel Corona d'Italia (www.hotelcoronaditalia.com), centrally located at the corner of the famous San Lorenzo Market. Naturally, we must finish up with dessert, so the tour will end at a gelateria for gelato and chocolate - fresh, natural ingredients only, here! The rest of the day is free to do as you please.

Day 5 Thursday, September 29:

Today our driver will pick us up at the hotel in a comfortable, 16-passenger vehicle for our trip to Certaldo. There we will spend the morning with Giuseppina at her renowned cooking school. We'll prepare a 4-course meal and enjoy it along with wine, and leave with a souvenir apron. We'll continue on to San Gimignano whose skyline is dominated by a multitude of medieval towers and its shops filled with art, artifacts and local products. This morning after breakfast, we'll devote our time to the wondrous Renaissance art of the Uffizi Gallery. After breakfast, we will have the day to tour, visit, re-visit, explore and, of course, shop for souvenirs. There are lots of options: a day trip to Pisa or Venice or Siena?
