MARITIME MEDLEY (Thursday, September 16 to Saturday, September 25, 2021)



A ten-day maritime medley of Celtic heritage and Acadian influences in Nova Scotia, Prince Edward Island and New Brunswick.

Day 1- Thursday September 16: (D)

Day 7- Wednesday September 22: (D)

A leisurely breakfast before a scenic drive to the magnificently restored fortress of Louisbourg. The day will be spent experiencing the garrison life of the French and English soldiers and settlers. The many presentations and an 18thC lunch will add to the reality. After crossing the Canso Causeway, a late afternoon arrival in Halifax. An orientation stroll before dinner and an evening to enjoy harbour nightlife.



Day 8- Thursday September 23:

Guided morning walking tour of the city's principal sites including Province House, St. Paul's Anglican Church, the Old Burying Ground and the Art Gallery of Nova Scotia. After lunch, a visit to the Citadel National Historic Site. Remainder of afternoon and evening at leisure.

Day 9- Friday September 24: (D)

After breakfast we travel to Peggy's Cove for the quintessential photo-op of our nation's signature Lighthouse. A scramble over the fascinating rock formations then on to Lunenburg, home port to the famous "dime" schooner Bluenose. Return to Halifax and opportunity for individual activities...a touch of retail Maritime therapy perhaps? This evening, however, our farewell dinner.
